
Year 1 - Spring 1 Learning Journey



Reading

Maths



Week 1- Measure: time, we will be starting to learn about time. We will be putting our daily routine into chronological order and beginning to understand half past and o'clock times.

Week 2- Number and place value: we will be understanding the term 'fair swap'.

Week 3 & 4- Addition and subtraction: We will be adding using the 'make 10' strategy, we will be understanding number families and solving missing number problems.

Week 5 & 6- Measure: Mass, we will be comparing and order objects and understanding mass and capacity.

Writing

Weeks 1-3 — The Toys go on an intergalactic adventure, we will be joining the toys on their adventure and retelling their story. We will be using drama, story maps and our sentence stacking to tell the story.

Week 3 & 6 - How would you feel if you lost your favourite toys? We are going to imagine we are the little boy and create a lost poster for his favourite toy. We are going to see if we can challenge ourselves to use question marks correctly!

We will be focussing on feelings, noticing, asking and actions.














We will also be focussing on improving our handwriting, ensuring our capital letters and lower case letters are the correct sizes and shapes. We will even start to join our handwriting.
