


Year 3 – Summer 2 Learning Journey



Reading

This half term our key text is 'Varjak Paw'. Varjak Paw is a pampered pet cat who knows there's more to life. His family teases him and don't understand his adventurous spirit. He is soon forced to venture beyond the garden wall to save his family from the mysterious and dangerous 'gentleman' and his two evil Hench-cats.

We will be learning how to answer questions based on different texts using the Destination Reader – Ready Reader stems which include:

- Predicting,
- Questioning,
- Clarifying,
- Summarising.



Children will continue to read a variety of books from the library and reading corners.

Writing

Weeks 1, 2 and 3 – We will be writing a narrative based on 'The Blue Umbrella' a Pixar animation.

Week 4, 5 & 6 – We will be writing a poem about colours based on the poem 'I asked the little boy who couldn't see.'

We will also be focussing on adverbs, personification, simile and feelings.



Maths



This term we are going to continue to work on our number skills and introduce some new areas to our maths learning.

Week 1 – Angles, and parallel & perpendicular lines.

Week 2 – Shapes and Geometry & Adding and subtracting mental methods.

Week 3 – Adding and subtracting using column method.

Week 4 – Multiplication and division.

Week 5 – Calculate complements to 100.

Week 6 – Multiplication and division facts focus of 10, 5, 2, 4 and 8.

Art & Design Technology



This half term we will be introduces to electrical systems and touching on simple circuit components and electric products. The children will be creating their own experience of a display system using their knowledge of electrical systems.

Computing



We will be using Scratch software to create animation through storytelling.

Another part of our computing lesson, we will be learning about database and storage through Microsoft Office and Google.

PSHE



In PSHE lessons we will be focusing on RSE. We will learning about personal hygiene, hygiene routines and understand the reasons for doing these things. We will also be looking at how common illnesses are spread and be able to describe how they can prevent the spread of one such illness.

Science



This term we are revisiting our science topics.

Our first focus will be on rocks, and our understanding of the different types of rocks, how they are formed and what are they used for.

The second focus will be on light, in this part of science we are revisiting how light if formed and how it travels. Focusing on shadows that are created with light and the changes that happens.

History

In History we will be revisiting our learning on the Stone Age. Building our understanding of Paleolithic (or Old Stone Age), Mesolithic (or Middle Stone Age), and Neolithic (or New Stone Age). Focussing on what changed and how life was during that time.

Geography

During this half term, we will be reminding ourselves about the different counties and regions of the United Kingdom.

In PE, our unit will be 'Health and Fitness'. We will learn about agility and balance. We will work on our floor work, ball chasing, and ball tricks. Along with building our
