


# The Year 6 – Summer 2 Learning Journey



## Reading

This term we are reading 'The Arrival' by Shaun Tan. The story follows a man who leaves his home to find work to support his family.

Through our Destination Reader lessons, children will get opportunities to develop their vocabulary and understanding of texts, using skills such as inference, summarising, and making predictions. The children will also express their opinions about what they have read and evaluate the effect and style of an author's writing. Once a week, the children will take part in a 'Big Picture' lesson in which they work to develop their skills with written comprehension tasks.

Through regular reading aloud to partners and adults, children will continue to develop their fluency and expression, which will help them to draw ever-greater pleasure from their reading.



## Maths



- Week 1- Four Operations
- Week 2- Geometry (Position and Direction)
- Week 3- Geometry- Properties of shapes
- Week 4 – Measurement – Volume, capacity and mass
- Week 5 – Measurement – Length and money
- Week 6 – Four operations - measurement

## Writing

Weeks 1-3 – The children will be writing an informal letter from the daughter's perspective discussing what life has been like since the father left.

Week 4 & 6 – The children will be writing a narrative where they will continue the story.

We will be mostly focussing on punctuation, feelings, cohesion, paragraphs and sentence structures.



## PE



The children will be working on developing their ability to persevere with a task and improve their performance through regular practice. They will learn how to react positively when things become difficult. They will continue building on the skills learnt in the previous unit.

## Science



We will be learning about 'Animals including humans'. The children will be learning about blood and what it is made of. They will learn about the circulatory systems and the function of organs. This will ensure that the children have an increased understanding of the importance of nutrients and how to keep healthy.

## Music



The children will be identifying and evaluating the musical features of a song, before collaboratively creating their own song. The children will then perform the leavers' song with confidence.

## History



This term, the children will be learning about a range of British monarchs and their legacy. They will then be discussing and deciding which monarch they think was the most significant.

## Computing



The children will be able to recognise that data can become corrupted within a network and recognise the differences between mobile data and WiFi. The children will learn how to use a spreadsheet to compare and identify high-use data activities and low-use data activities.

## MFL



Throughout this term we will be learning about directions and prepositional phrases, whilst recapping their prior learning.

## PSHE

In PSHE lessons we will be learning about RSE.



## RE

In our RE lessons, we will be learning about Islam, where they will discuss beliefs and moral values.
