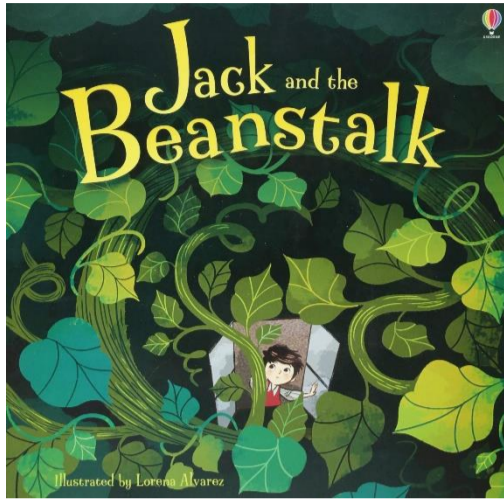


# Year 1 – Autumn 1 Learning Journey



## Reading

We will be reading a selection of fairytales this half term. We will start with Jack and the beanstalk. This is a classic fairytale that has been retold for young children. We will be enjoying the journey that Jack takes and the adventure he goes on. We will then read Little Red Riding Hood and Pinocchio.

We will discuss the stories as a class. We will try and predict what we think will happen and ask lots of questions about the different stories. We will be fully immersing ourselves in the texts with different experience days, linking to our writing, geography and art work.

We will continue to have Read Write Inc every day where we will be focusing on specific letter sounds and how to blend these into words with a particular focus on reading more fluently.



## Maths

ArkCurriculum+

In maths this half term, children will be learning about numbers to 10. They will be making numbers up to 10 using concrete resources and then will move onto recognising doubles and halves. After this, children will be learning about addition and subtraction within 10 followed by recognising 2d and 3d shapes as well as patterns.

## PE

Children will be taught Personal Skills. They will learn about coordination and balance and learn about footwork. We will also be taking part in multi-sports and will learn about the different skills they are needed.

## Art & DT

This term the children will be learning how to draw and will use different techniques – this will link to their learning on seasonal changes. In DT, children will be designing and making a slider product as well as evaluating it too.



## Computing

Programming is introduced through the use of a Bee-Bot; exploring its functions, creating a video to explain its capabilities, undertaking an unplugged activity, creating a world for a Bee-Bot to explore and programming Bee-Bots to tell a story.



## Science



We will be learning about seasonal changes. Children will learn about the 4 seasons and how the weather changes throughout the seasons. We will also learn about day and night and how the earth spins.

## History



We are learning about changes within living memory. We will be looking at how toys change as we get older. We will discuss what toys we play with now and what toys we played with when we were babies.

## Music

In music we will be learning about singing. We will be focusing on nursery rhymes and understanding what a rhyme is. We will also be co-ordinating actions with singing. We will then learn that some songs tell a story and will be reflecting on the impact of singing together.



## RE



In our RE lessons, we will be looking at the Christian creation story. We will be answering the question. 'Does God want Christians to look after the world?' We will look at how we can also look after our world.

## PSHE

In PSHE we will be looking at beginning and belonging. We will be creating our own classroom ground rules and building positive relationships in the class. We will discuss what it feels like to be in a new situation and how to cope with that.
